2015 ORILLIA FILM FESTIVAL SUBMISSION RULES

FESTIVAL MISSION:

The mission of the Orillia Film Festival is to encourage the art of storytelling through film in our community. It is our hope that the festival will develop another facet to Orillia's growing arts scene by inspiring local and not so local film-makers to put their talents to work and by offering up the best creations in a community building event in downtown Orillia!

DATES:

The Orillia Film Festival has two nights: Local Night is for local films only and is on September 25. Award Night ON September 26 is for the best local films and a selection of the best short films from around the world. Both nights will be held at the Orillia Opera House.

ELIGIBILITY:

- **Maximum length: 8 minutes** - films that exceed the maximum length will not be considered.
- Submit 1 DVD screening copy clearly labeled with your name, contact information and the film's title and 1 DVD digital copy (Quicktime file)
- Submit a complete credit list (director, producer, actors, etc)
- Entries must be available for screening at the festival on DVD.
- Entries previously submitted and not accepted may not be resubmitted.
- Misrepresentation, incorrectly completed entry forms or missing information may lead to the disqualification of your submission.
- If your film is selected, the Orillia Film Festival reserves the right to promote it in media campaigns and to reproduce the film for internal and/or promotional use, and post it on our website and social media.
- Entries must be accompanied by a completed submission form and the \$20 entry fee
- Submission screening copies must be sent in protective packaging. The Orillia Film Festival is not responsible for lost or damaged submissions. Submissions will not be returned.

DEADLINE:

August 7, 2015 - 5:00 pm Sorry, but late submissions will not be considered.

AWARDS:

Films and videos are judged on the basis of quality, originality, technical execution, and content by an impartial jury. The rulings of the jury are final and are not open to appeal. Depending on the number of submissions, a curator may select finalists for jury consideration. The top three films, as chosen by the Orillia Film Festival Jury will receive 6 free tickets to the both show nights at the Orillia Opera House, a copy of Cyberlink's Power Director 12 Software, a copy of Final Draft 8.0, and the following monetary awards:

1st place: \$500 2nd place: \$300 3rd place: \$200

ORILLIA HOME GROWN AWARD:

Submissions to the Orillia Film Festival may be considered for the Home Grown Award for Best Local Movie, which has a cash prize of **\$200** in addition to any other awards received. To qualify as "Orillia Home Grown" a film must:

- Have been filmed within 50 km of Orillia, Ontario, Canada **or**
- Have been written or directed by a former or current Orillia resident **or**
- Have a defensible connection to the Orillia-area, as judged by the Orillia Film Festival Jury

BEST TEEN DOCUMENTARY FILM AWARD:

Documentary film-makers between the ages of 13-19 will be eligible for the Best Teen Documentary Film Award, with a cash prize of \$250 in addition to any other awards received. Sponsored by the Stokreef Family.

BEST "GREEN" FILM AWARD:

The Simcoe North Federal Green Party Association are the sponsors of this \$200 award, to be granted to the film that best reflects any or all of the core Green values of Ecological Wisdom, Non-violence, Social Justice, Sustainability, Participatory Democracy, and Respect for Diversity.
